

Background

In Nepal, on average three people die every hour due to the tobacco related diseases and **27,137** Nepalese die due to tobacco-related disease. This survey provides important insights into the use of tobacco, and the attitude and behaviors behind its continued popularity.

Methodology

2800 households in **49** Districts of Nepal were surveyed. A multi-stage sampling with mix of probability proportional to size and systematic random sampling was used to produce representative data.

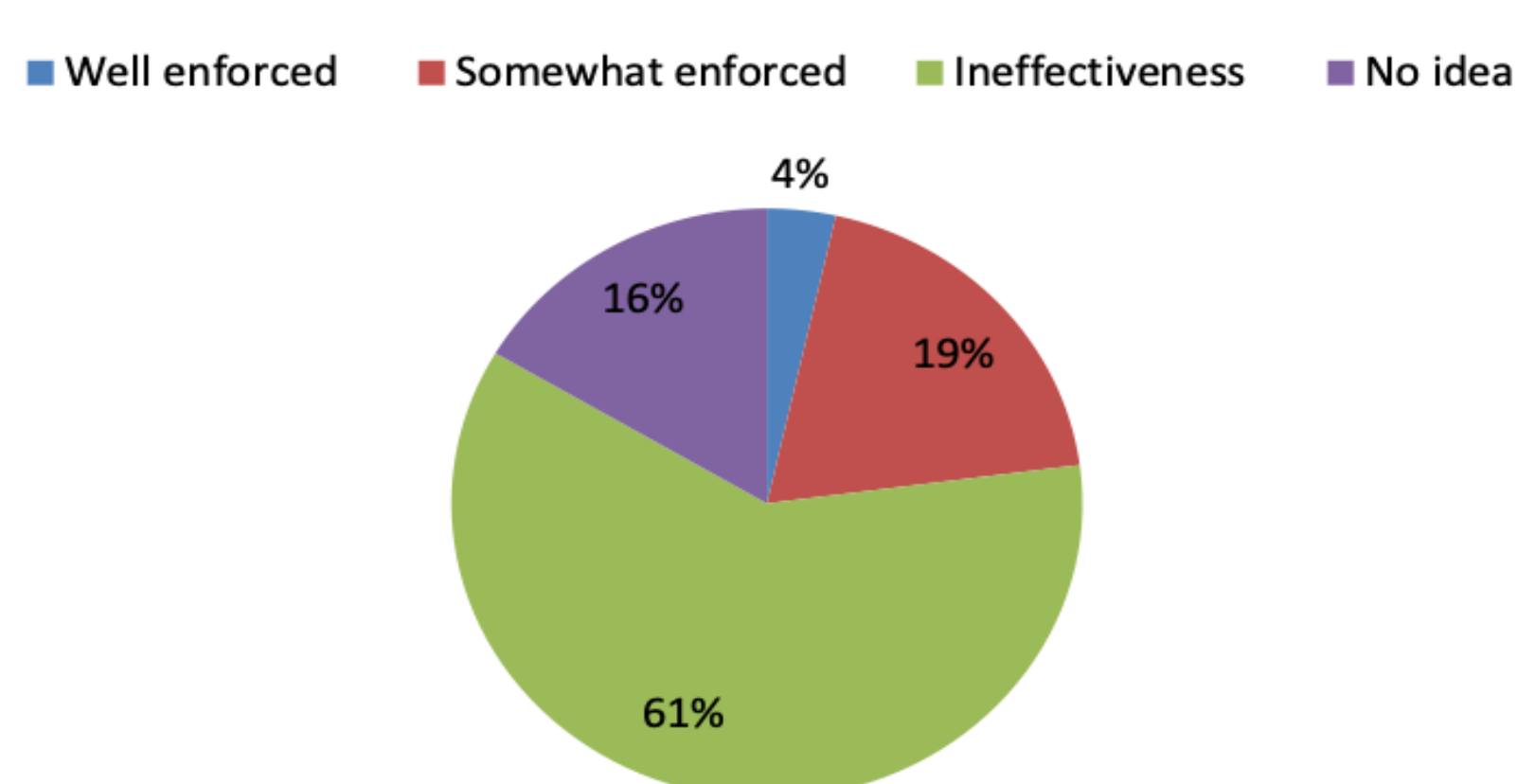

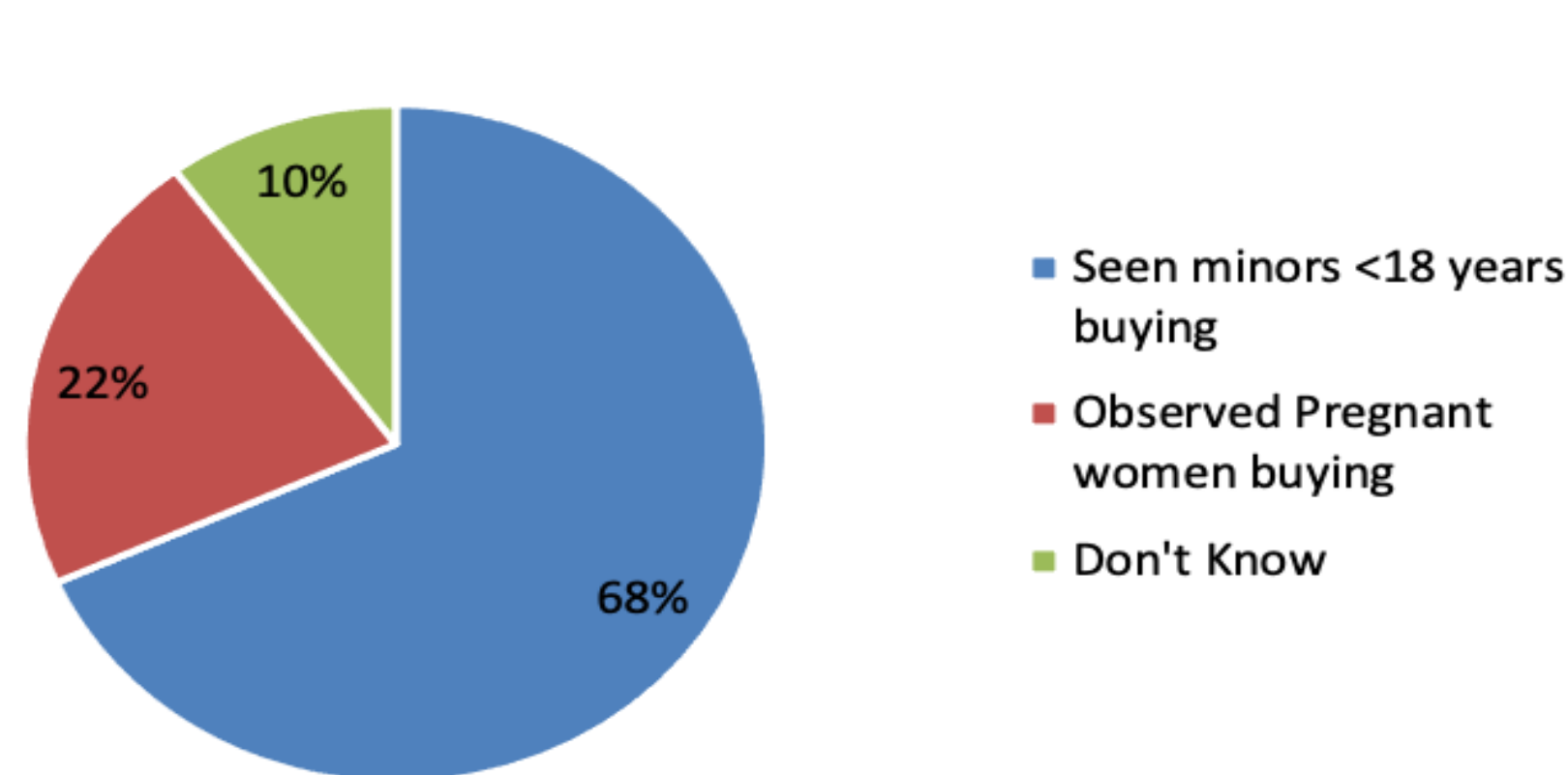

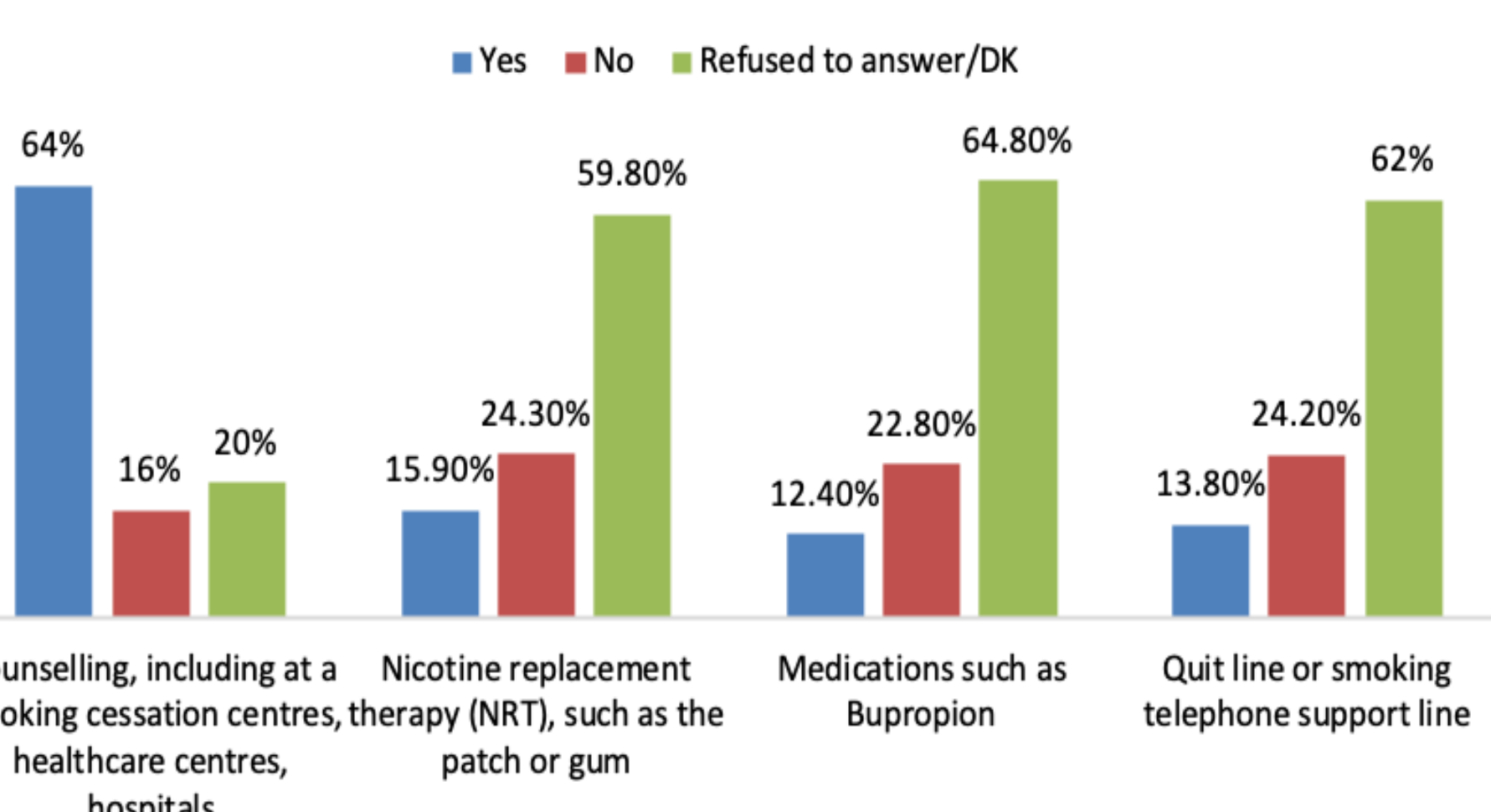

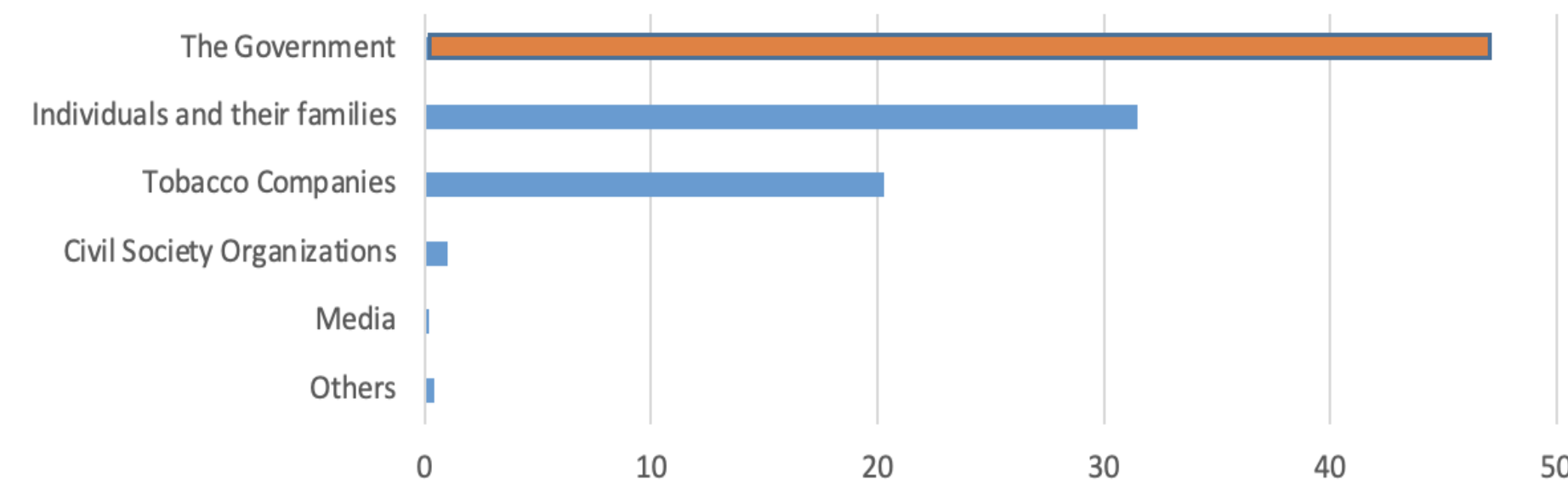

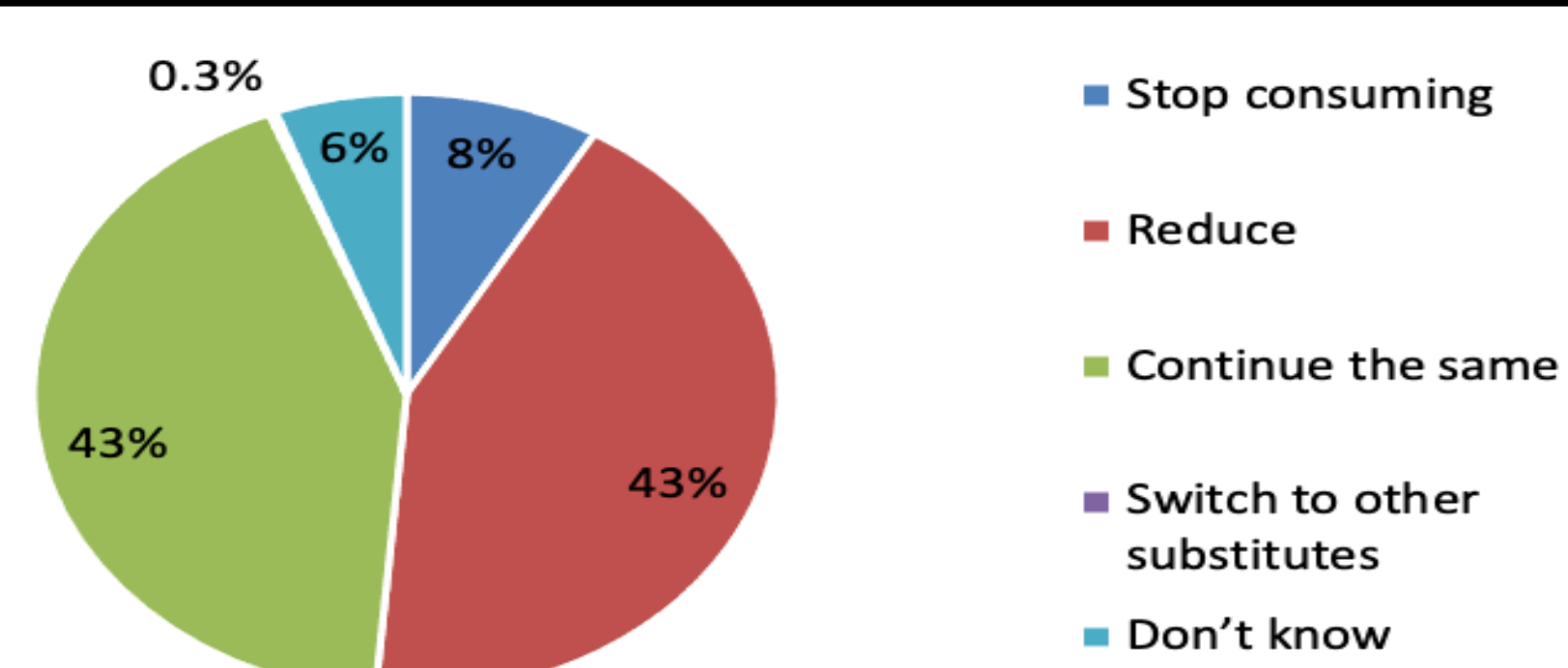

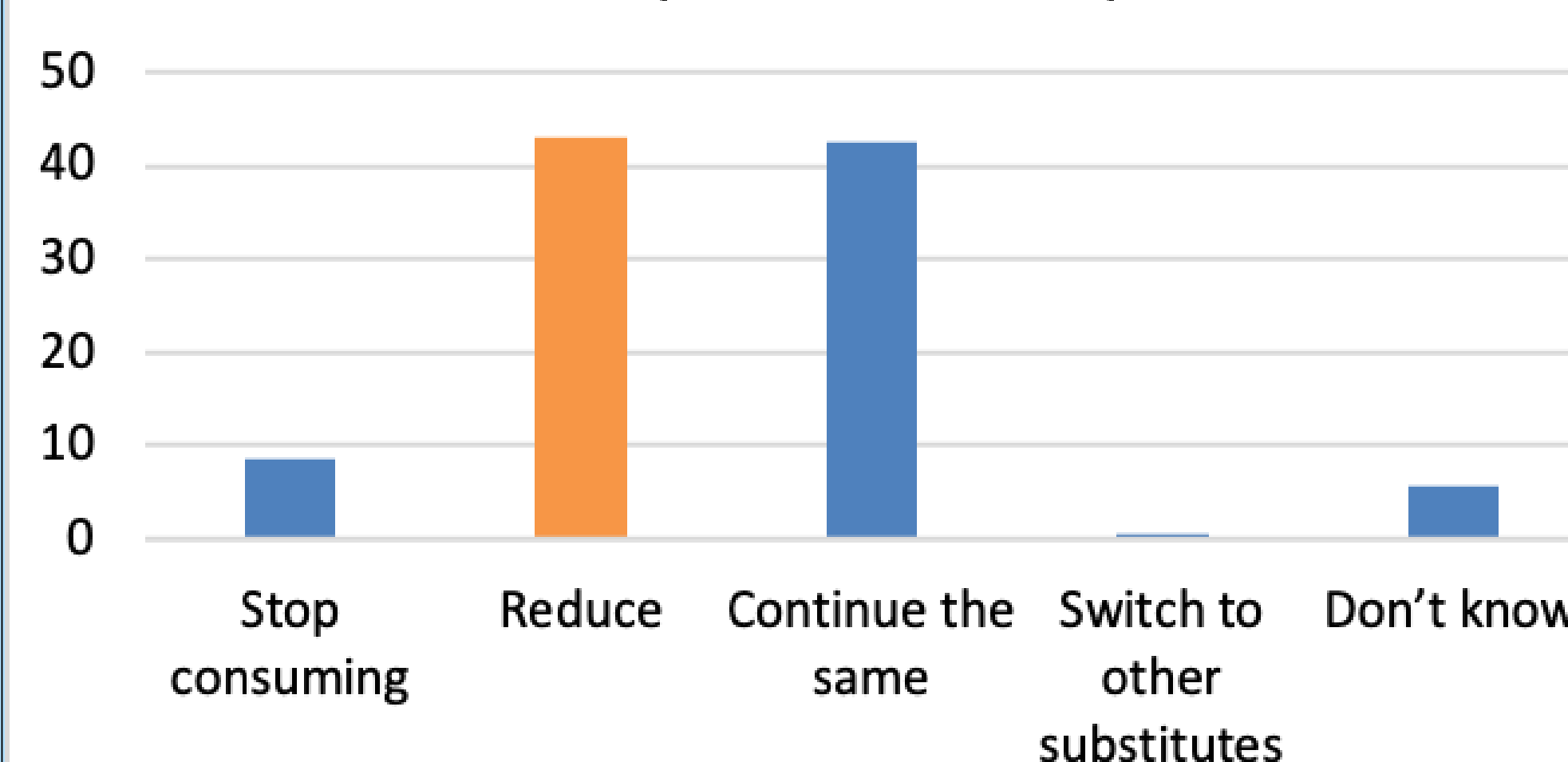
Tobacco users response if tobacco price doubled

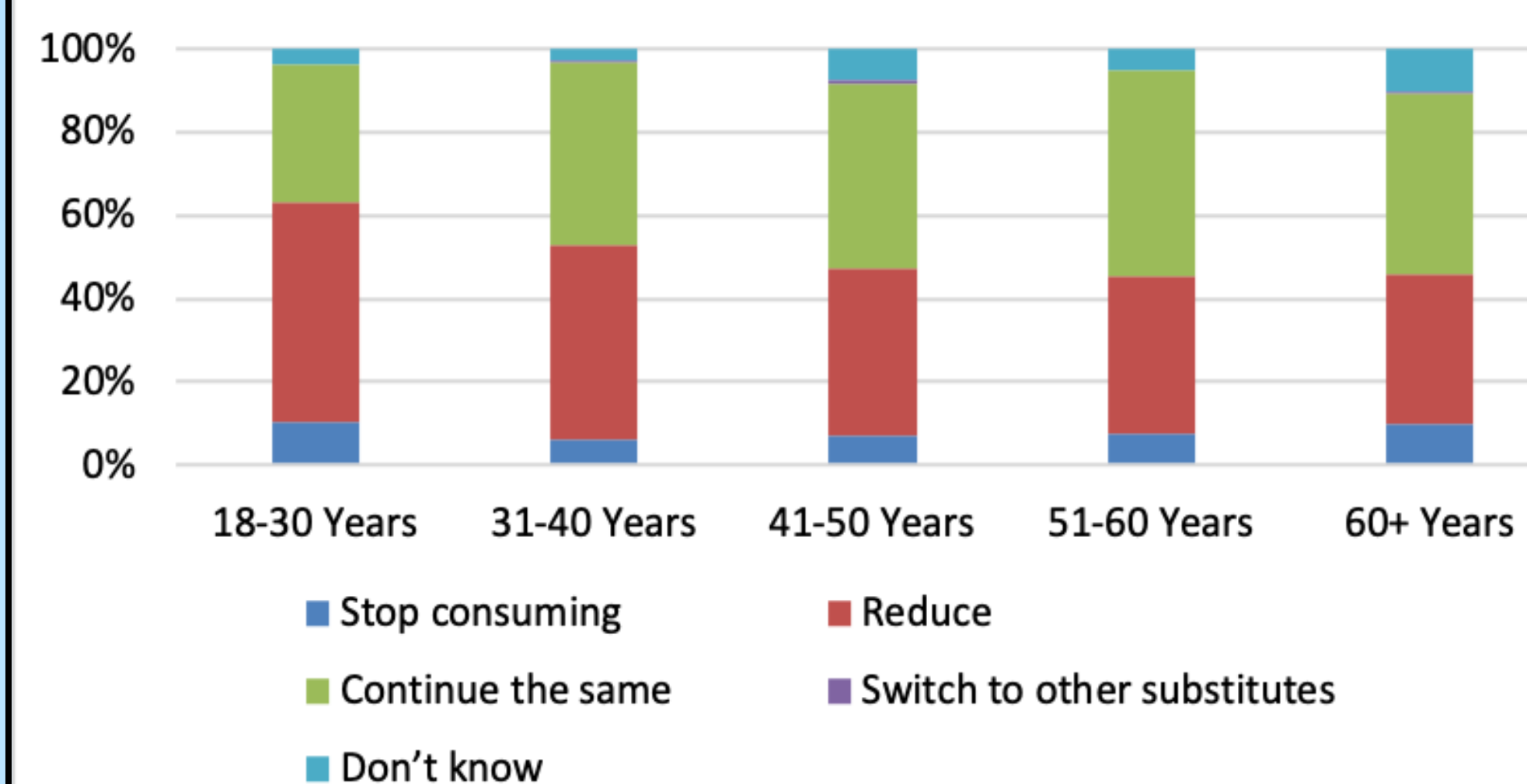
Response on Price Double

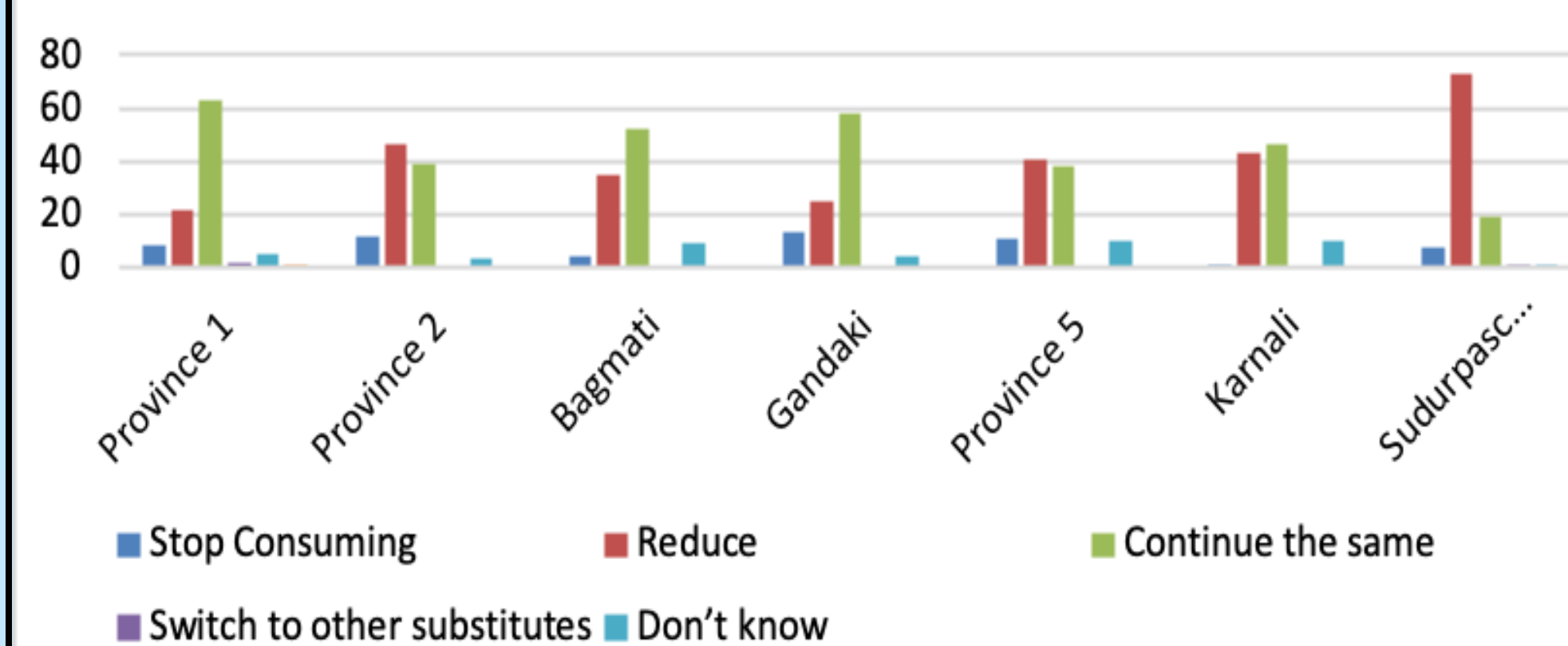

Age-wise response on if the price of the tobacco product is doubled

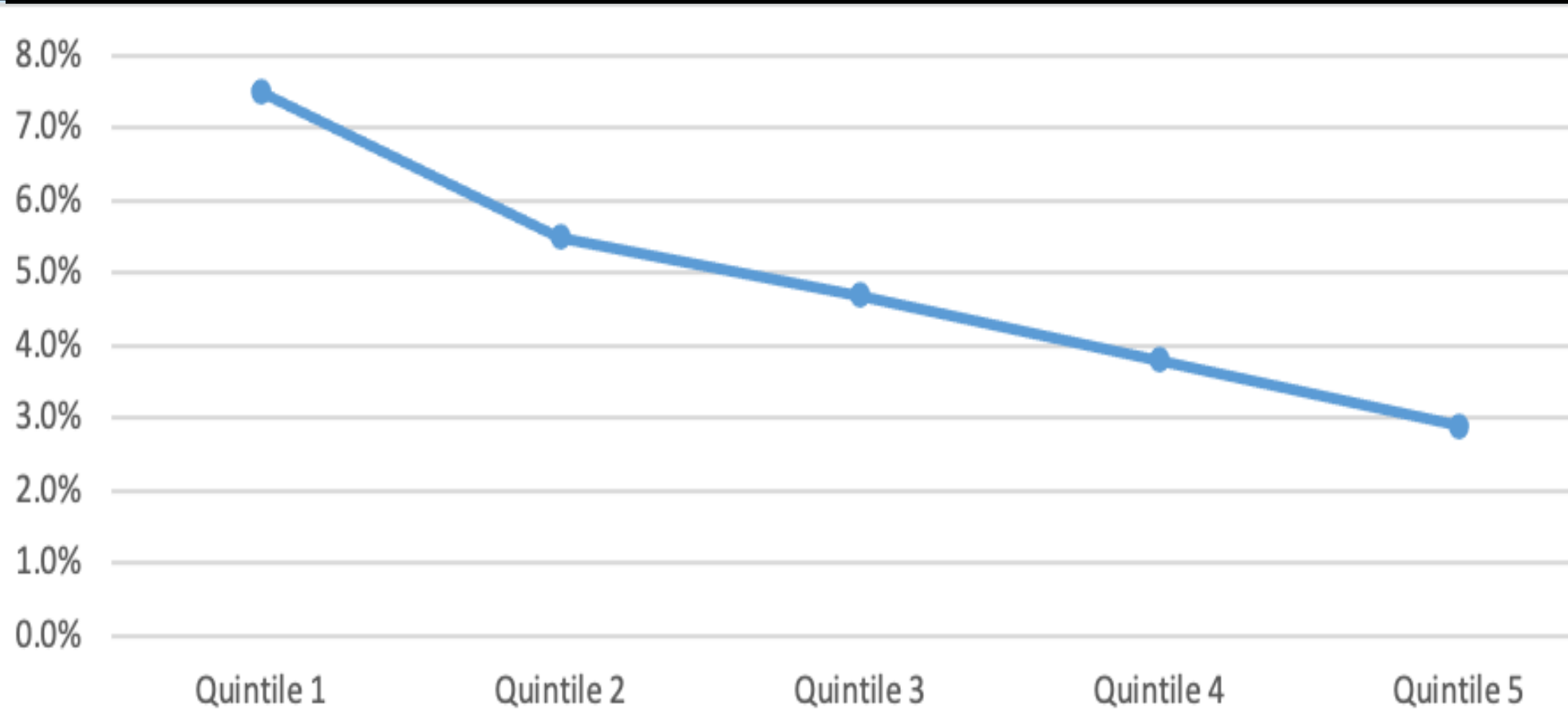


Age-wise response on if the price of the tobacco product is doubled

Province wise response if price of the tobacco product is doubled.



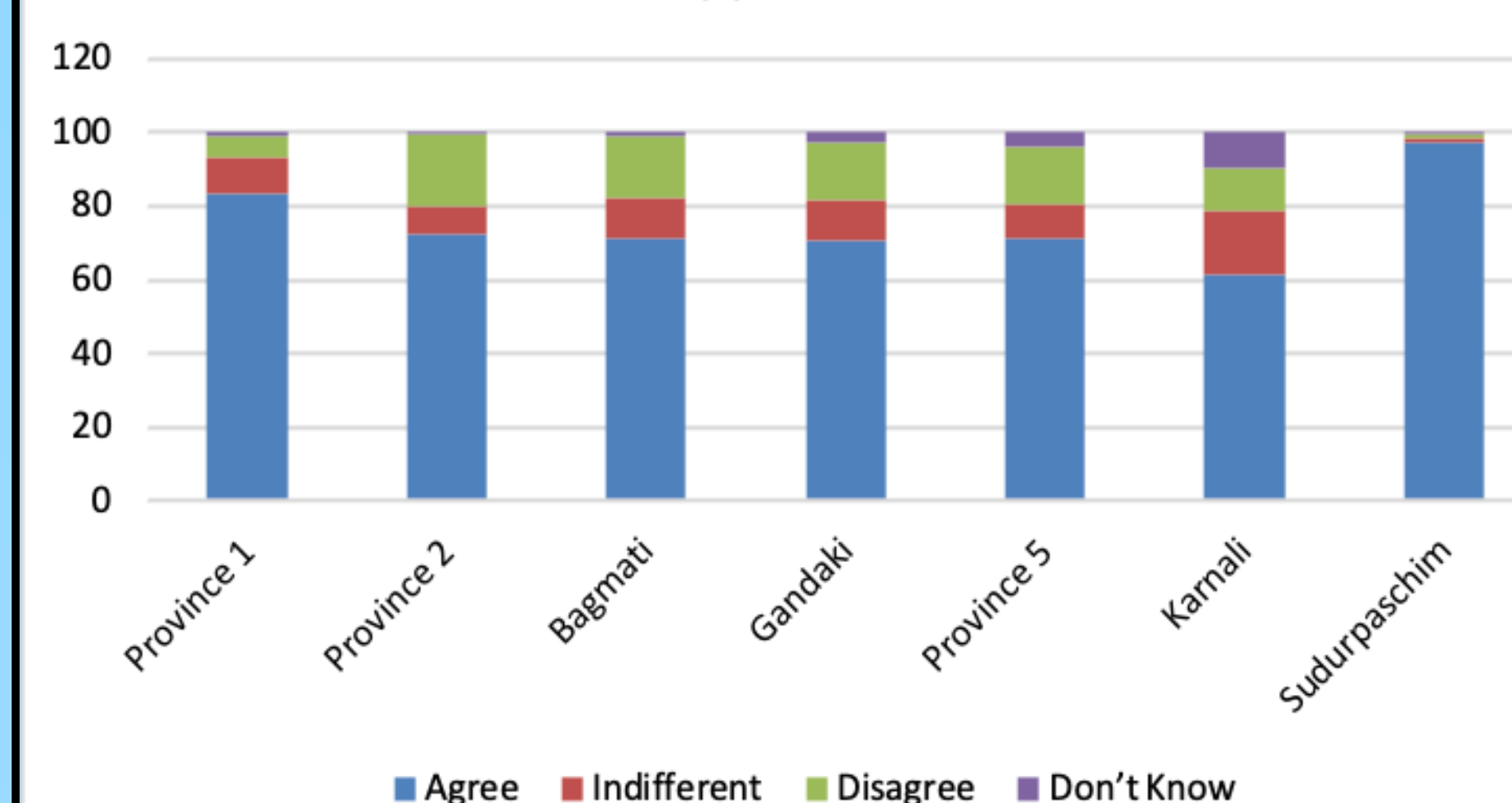
Province wise response if price of the tobacco product is doubled



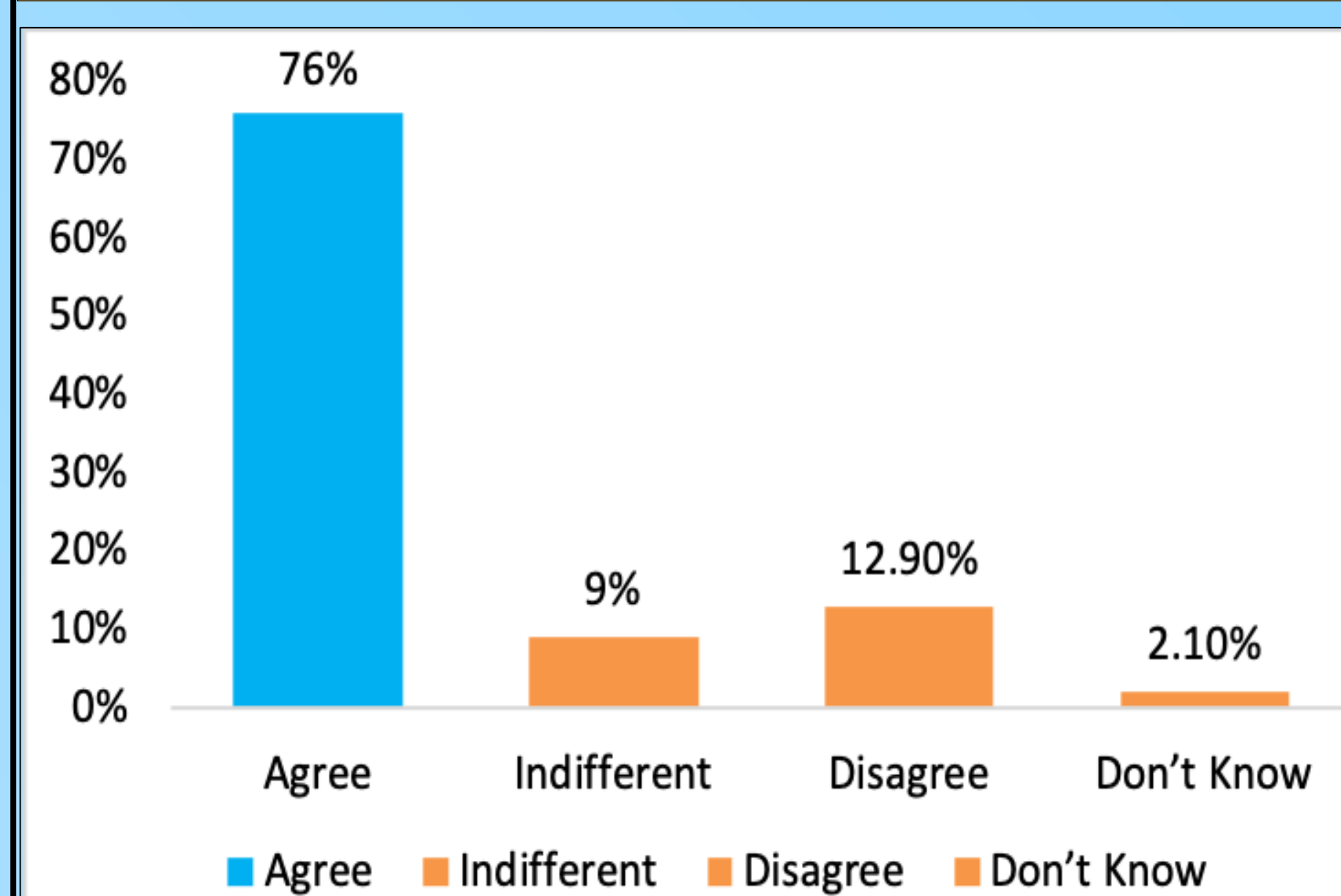
Percentage of income spent on tobacco decreases in the higher per capita expenditure quintile.

Province wise support to increase in taxes

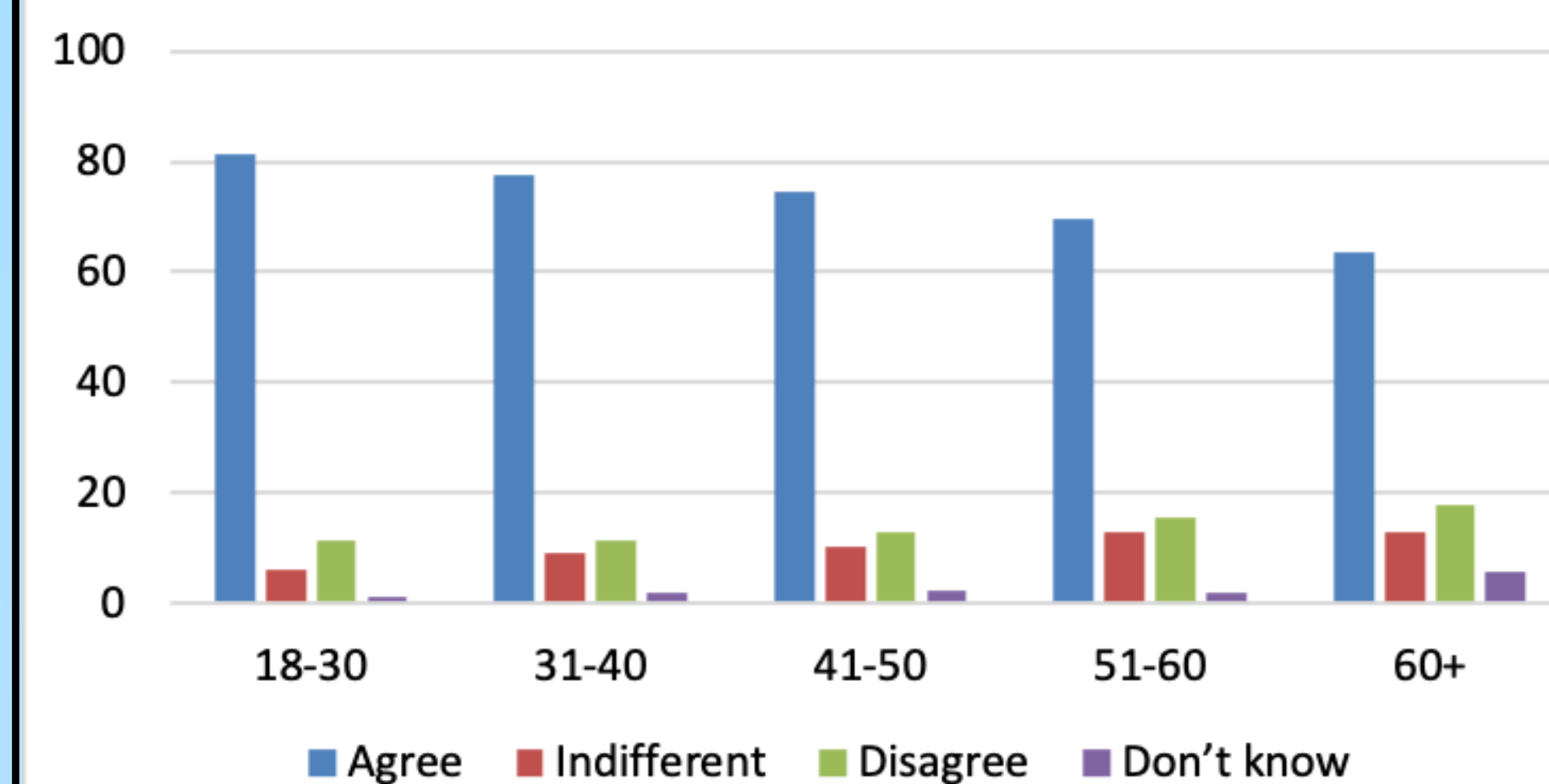


Province wise support to increase in taxes

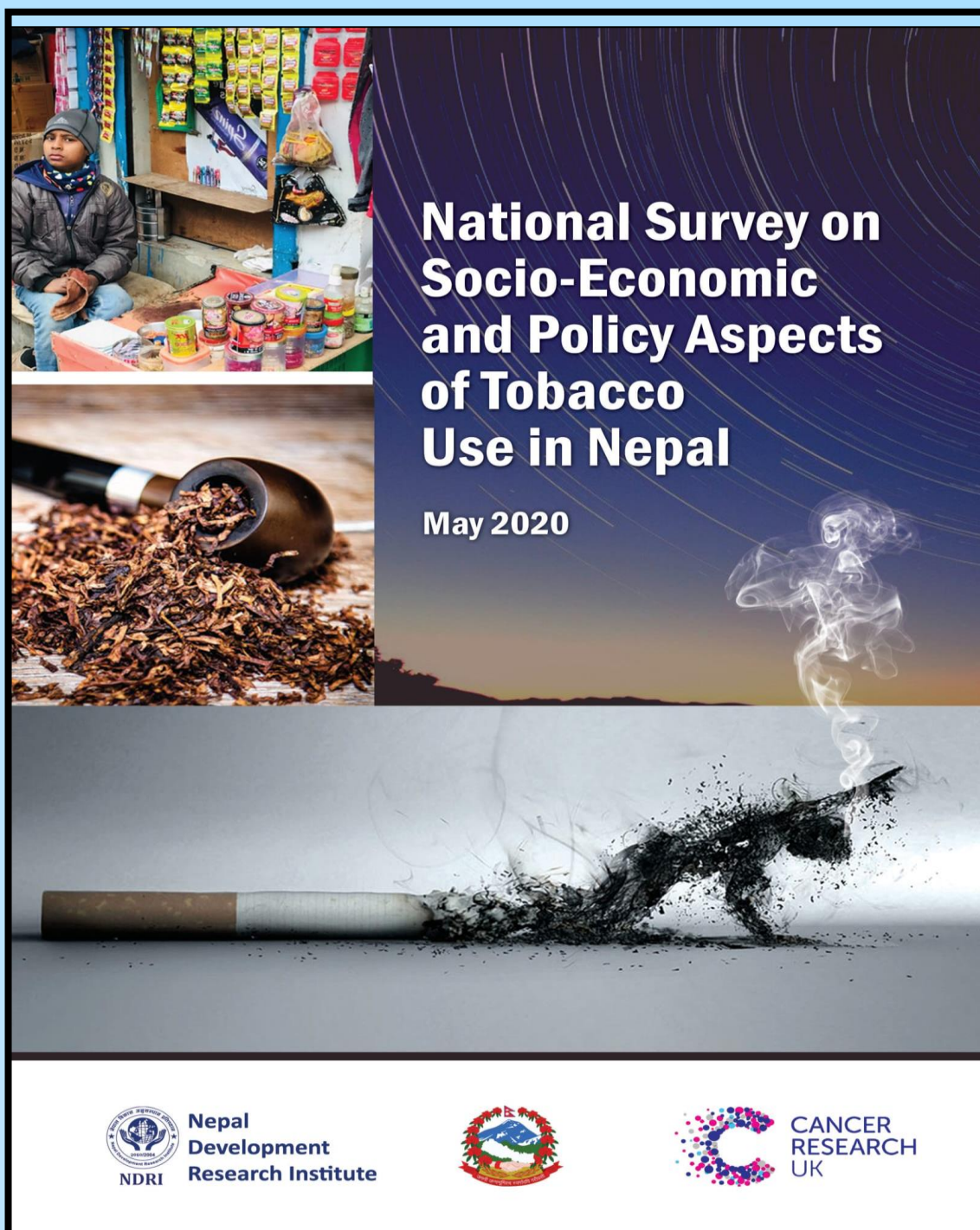


Support for tax increase
